

## **Can I still apply to study at Exeter College in September 2020?**

We will continue to process any applications that have been received via our online application system by remote working. Usually we meet all applying learners for an individual interview. However, given Public Health England's advice that we support learners and staff to limit travel where possible, we are now offering students a conditional offer to secure your place at Exeter College. A conditional offer will be given if all relevant information has been received. If we require further information, we will contact you and place your application on hold until we receive the required details.
